Biography

Sasha is a Co-Founder of theatre company and charity Compass Collective that works with young people seeking sanctuary in the UK. With Compass Collective she has co-directed shows at Shakespeare's Globe, The Southwark Playhouse and The Arcola theatre, and festivals including, Migration Matters Festival and Tate Lates.

Sasha's work has a strong core in community and ensemble, and she wishes to continue to progress this into her future practice. She is interested in landscapes and architecture and how these live in the body. The focus of her work is the integration of culture, nature, knowledge and experiences.
