As part of her training on the MA Movement: Directing and Teaching, Maya has taught the BA1 Actors in stamina classes, as well as the BA1 Collaborative Devised Theatre Students (CDT) in Dance. Maya has most recently Movement Directed 'Grande Finale' by Copi, directed by Than Hussein Clark. She also Movement Directs within her Photography and Filmmaking work. As a Choreographer for screen, Maya co-choreographed Episode 3 of Soumik Datta Arts' series 'Silent Spaces.' The winner of Best Short Film at Manchester Lift-Off Global Network Film Festival, 'Sometimes They Sing', (directed by herself and Andy McCredie) was also Movement Directed by and Choreographed by Maya.

Maya is passionate about Dance Theatre and Physical Theatre. She is particularly excited by creative working opportunities that are very physical, narrative-based, conceptual, and allow for abstract and expressive movement. With her professional work as a Photographer and Filmmaker, Maya is a multidisciplinary artist.
